The design of a given robotic system will often incorporate principles of Mechanical engineering, Electronic engineering and Computer science particularly Artificial intelligence. The study of biological systems often plays a key role in the Systems engineering of a project and also forms the field of Bionics. The mathematical expression of a biological system may give rise to control algorithms for example, or by observing how a process is handled by nature







It was founded in 1947 and is the world's largest and most prestigious scientific and educational computing society. It is a not-for-profit professional membership group. Its membership is more than 100,000 as of 2011. Its headquarters are in New York City.

The ACM and the IEEE Computer Society are the primary US umbrella organizations for academic and scholarly interests in computing. Unlike the IEEE, the ACM is solely dedicated to computing.

ACM @ MJCET is under the aegis of ACM- Association for Computing Machinery. ACM the world's largest educational and scientific computing society, delivers resources that advance computing as a science and a profession.

ACM @ MJCET is a student chapter of ACM at Muffakham Jah College of Engineering and Technology (MJCET). The Association for Computing Machinery is the world's largest educational and scientific computing society, uniting educators, researchers and professionals to inspire dialogue, share resources and address the field's challenges.


ICI (INDIAN CONCRETE INSTITUTE)







Ham radio Club
